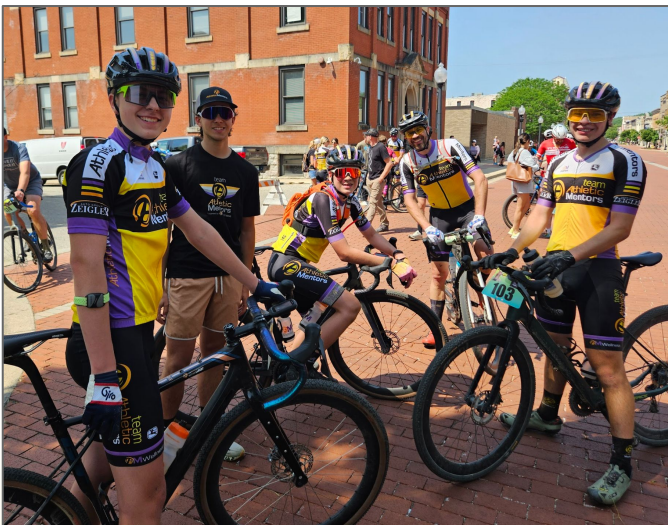

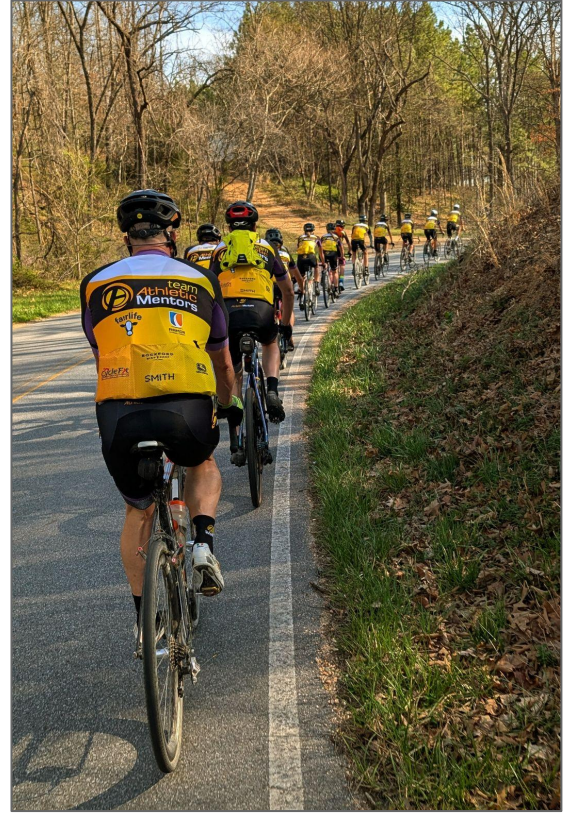

The JD Tri Team spent the weekend together learning life lessons, participating in a local tri event and even had time to do some team bonding with lake activities supported by the host family.

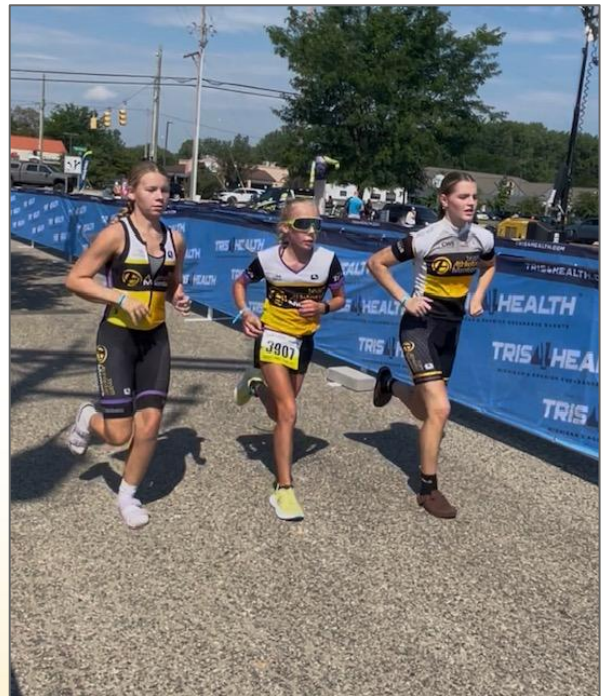
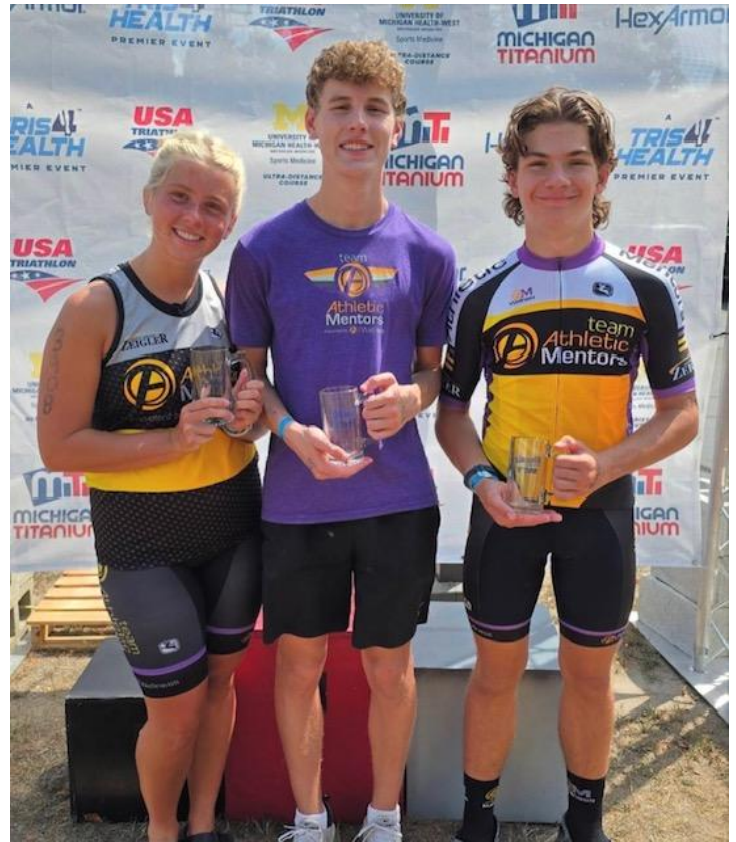

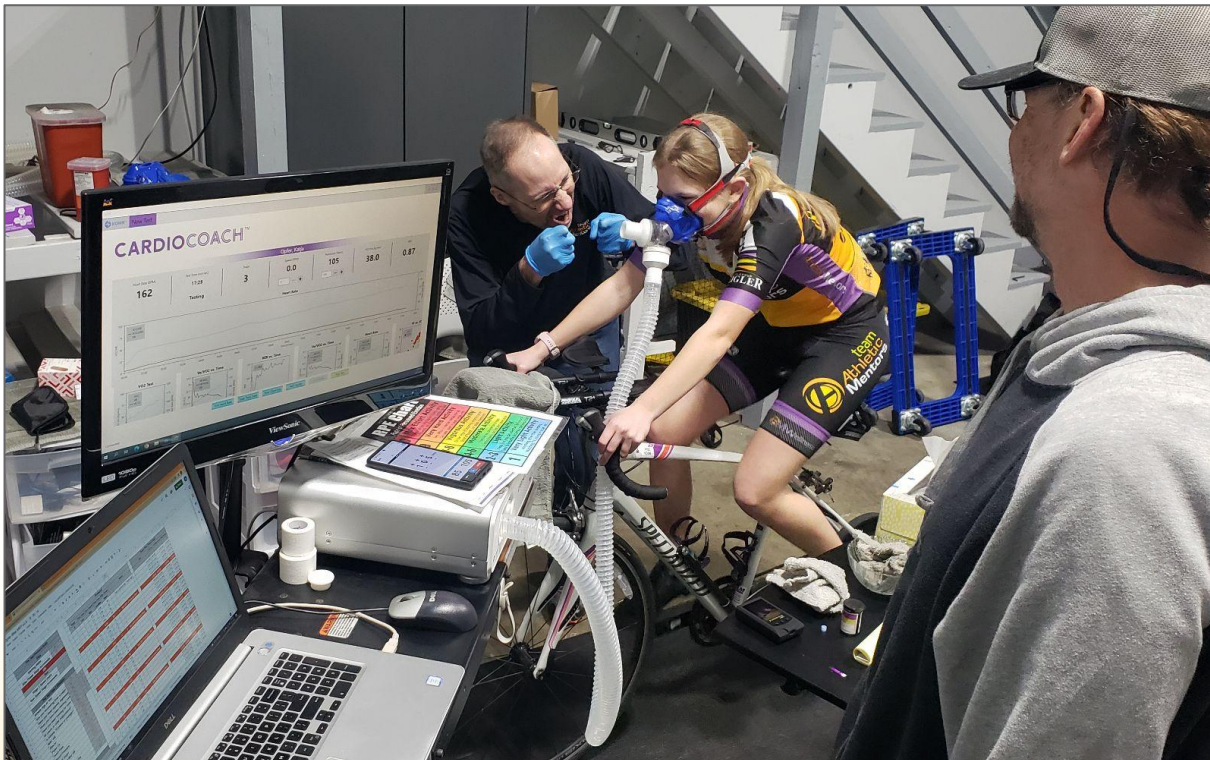
